Imagine you can create your very own world.


Write a story about a world you would like to live in. Try to think of things in the world that you currently live in that you would like to keep the same, or change.



Use the categories below to help guide you in your worldbuilding

First, make a list of everything that you love about the world you live in.

Then, make another list of everything you would change about your world.



Think of these categories when making your world:

Human: What qualities do you love in people? What qualities would you like to include in your humans and what qualities would you leave out?

Organization: What is the structure of your world? Do you have a leader to look up to? Do people have jobs like they do today? Do homes look the same as they do now? Do people still go to school?



Object: What are some objects that you would take from this world into the world you are building? Objects are things people own, for example, cars, toys, computers, phones, furniture, etc.

Animal: Does your world have animals and if so, what kind? Do humans have pets? Are you including any animals that have gone extinct?

Food: What kinds of foods are available to eat? Do humans continue to eat food like we do now, or does it look different?
